

**Wilson Township Meeting Minutes**  
**Regular Meeting**  
**September 14, 2022**

The meeting was called to order at 6:58 p.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance. Board members present include Dan Hibner, Mike Centala, Penny Szatkowski, and Cody Werth. Absent was Melissa Werth.

Motion was made by Cody Werth, supported by Mike Centala, to accept the August 10, 2022 regular meeting minutes. All in favor. Motion carried.

Jake Trelfa reported that the Wilson Township Fire Department Cornhole Tournament and Chili Cookoff set for September 24 at noon is coming along well. They currently are working on getting prizes.

Kevin Trelfa reported that Wolf Creek Park has a Library Box in place. Locking the bathroom in November is planned. They are looking for a nice, but practical garbage can that will be emptied on an as-needed basis. Lawn mowing is well done.

Dan Hibner reported that Wilson School Pack is seeking a charitable gaming license for their Lady's Night Out. They need formal approval by their local government to do so.
